Other Accomplishments: Bill is a four-time winner of the Boston Marathon (1975, '78, '79, '80) and the New York Marathon (1976, '77, '78, '79). He dropped out of the 1999 Boston Marathon while trying to break the **M50** course record. Now a prostate cancer survivor Bill erased the memory of that DNF by finishing the 2009 Boston Marathon in 4:06:49 at the age of 61. In August he added a 51:25 for the 2009 Falmouth 7 mile Run.
